EXAMPLE on VOLUNTEER HOURS

There are 4 questions on volunteer hours

- How many volunteer hours do you estimate branch members spent supporting Veterans activities ?
- How much volunteer hours do you estimate branch members spent supporting seniors programs?
- How many volunteer hours do you estimate branch members spent supporting youth activities?
- How many volunteer hours do you estimate branch members spent supporting charitable activities or organizations?

Let's take Youth activities - there are a few different activities we sponsor

- a] Public Speaking
- b] Poem, Poster, Essay
- c] Youth Darts
- d] Track and Field

Report the hours that are actually involved with the Youth or judging procedures, (include all individuals that help during these times)

That would go the same for the other 3 questions

Veterans - actual hours that is spent with Veterans' events the branch holds (dinners, visit to homes, etc.)

Seniors - actual hours that is spent holding events for seniors (dances, sports etc)

Charitable activities or Organizations - actual hours that is spent holding events (fundraisers etc.)

For all of these remember that there are a few volunteers contributing their time.

Example:

Senior activities at a branch (2 activities held for the seniors - dances and shuffleboard) - Branches probably support more than 2 different types of programs for their seniors:

A senior dance is held once monthly for the year for 4 hours each night (plus an hour let's say for pre-dance preparations) and there are 4 volunteers for each night taking care of the event,

Hours for that event - $5 \times 4 = 20$ hours/month,

Total hours for the year - 240 hours

The branch holds a monthly senior shuffleboard for the year. If the event is 3 hours in length and there are 4 volunteers helping with the event the calculation would be:

Hours for the event - $3 \times 4 = 12$ hours/month

Total hours for the year - 144 hours

Those are the only 2 programs that this branch supports for seniors then they would record **240+144=384** for the time period of June 1, 2017-May 31, 2018. (I would approximate it to 400)
