## 2017 – 2019 GENERAL BY-LAWS

### UPDATE NO. 4 – PEC AMENDMENTS

THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENTS TO THE GBLO (GENERAL BY-LAWS OF THE ONTARIO PROVINCIAL COMMAND) AND GBLB (THE GENERAL BY-LAWS FOR BRANCHES OF THE ONTARIO PROVINCIAL COMMAND) WERE PASSED AT THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE PROVINCIAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL HELD IN AURORA ON THE 17<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2018. PURSUANT TO SECTION 512. a. GBL (THE GENERAL BY-LAWS) THESE AMENDMENTS WERE SUBMITTED TO THE DOMINION COMMAND CONSTITUTION AND LAWS COMMITTEE FOR APPROVAL WHICH WAS GRANTED ON THE 11<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF JANUARY, 2019 WITH MINOR CHANGES RESPECTING THE APPOINTMENT APPEALS. THE CURRENT EDITION OF THE COMMAND BY-LAWS WILL BE ACCORDINGLY AMENDED AS TO DECEMBER 2018.

<u>SECTION</u>	<u>SUMMARY RE AMENDMENT APPLICATION</u>
AMENDMENTS TO GBLO	
<b>S. 503. (4)</b>	<i>New Subsection:</i> Establishes the Members through their Office that comprise the Provincial Finance Committee. It includes the Honorary Treasurer and avoids previous confusion.
<b>S. 504</b>	<i>Subdivide the previous Section and add another subsection:</i> Provides more latitude to the Provincial President to appoint Committees and Standalone Positions also setting the Term.
<b>S. 603. (4)</b>	<i>The wording was corrected:</i> With the addition of the composition of the Provincial Finance Committee the entry re Members was removed and the addition of the Command Accountant.
<b>S. 707. (1)</b>	<i>House cleaning:</i> Section wording reconfigured.
<b>S. 807. (1)</b>	<i>House cleaning:</i> Section wording reconfigured.
<b>S. 1002.</b>	<i>Previous wording replaced:</i> The new wording was developed to formalize the process and procedure respecting Awards etc. that require Command approval.
<b>S. 1004. (1) (d)</b>	<i>Wording change:</i> The new wording relies on the application of Administrative Instructions rather than relying on the Article III Appeal process.
<b>S. 1004. (2)</b>	<i>New Subsection:</i> This clarifies who may be considered as the Appointing Authority for the purpose of terminating an Appointment.

AMENDMENTS TO GBLB	
<b>S. 410. (1) (d)</b>	<b>Wording change:</b> The new wording relies on the application of Administrative Instructions rather than relying on the Article III Appeal process.
<b>S. 410. (2)</b>	<b>New Subsection:</b> This clarifies who may be considered as the Appointing Authority for the purpose of terminating an Appointment.
<b>S. 1013.</b>	<b>New Section:</b> <i>This was added to ensure that all those Members assuming an Office requiring Installation are installed prior to formally assuming such Office.</i>
