Comrades:

Since year #10 of our Military Service Recognition Book program has now been completed, we now wish to introduce you to year #11 of this important Remembrance Program.

In doing so, we are asking Branches to have an MSRB Coordinator appointed to actively promote our program for Veteran submissions within their Branch. For the past two years now, the number of Veteran submissions that we have received has not been enough to fill our books. And a low number of our Branches have submitted Veteran submissions for our books. As a result, we have had to utilize Youth Education entries in our Provincial Youth Education competitions as well as previous Veteran submissions that had already been published.

For this reason, we are appealing to all Branches not to wait until the last minute to submit Veteran submission to our Provincial Coordinators but rather to **<u>START NOW</u>** with your recruitment.

Please utilize all of the documents included in this Introductory Package to their fullest in promoting our program within your Branch and your community. All proper procedures for submissions are outlined in the "Fact Sheet" included with this introductory package. Although a submission form is included in this package, fillable submission forms are also available on our Ontario Provincial Command website at www.on.legion.ca.

We ask that you support our program at your Branch by **communicating the information with your Executive members, the Branch membership, and Branch staff so that everyone at the Branch is fully aware of our program and the need for Veteran submissions.** Once a Branch Coordinator has checked submissions for correctness, and all information is accurate, complete, and legible, and a proper photo has been submitted, they are then to be sent to our Provincial Command Coordinators. <u>THEY ARE NOT TO BE SENT TO OUR COMMAND OFFICE</u>.
