As we proceed with our rebuild, the time is coming that we will have to decide on a design for our new building. The Insurance company has stated that we will have to build with "Like Kind and Quality." Our

building was approximately 13,500 square feet, which was huge. We are hoping that we can negotiate a slightly smaller and more efficient building design.
