The presentation will be made by Ontario Command's 1st Vice President Lynn McClellan; joining him will be several members of the Royal Canadian Legion, Ontario Command.

Please be advised that this will be the Ceremonial launch of the 2022 Poppy Campaign only; the official start of the Poppy Campaign will be Friday, October 28, 2022.
