



## Application for Veteran Plate Eligibility Certification

## Instructions:

- Applicant must complete Section 1, 2 and 3 and mail form, photocopies of proof of service, fee and a self addressed stamped envelope to the Royal Canadian Legion Office address at the top of this application form.
- Make cheque or money order in the amount of \$5.00 payable to: The Royal Canadian Legion, Ontario Provincial Command.

- After Section 4 of the form is completed by the Royal Canadian Legion, the applicant must submit the form to a ServiceOntario centre to receive a veteran plate.

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Section 1 - Eligibility Criteria for Ontario Veteran Plate. Check ☑ applicable box.	THE RESERVE OF THE
Veteran plates are available to any person who is or has honourably:	
A) Served in the Canadian Forces including Reserve Forces, the forces of the Commonwealth or its wartime allies	
B) Served in the Merchant Navy or Ferry Command during wartime	
C) Currently serving members of the Canadian Forces including Reserve Forces	
D) Peace Officers who served in a special duty area or on a special duty operation (NATO/UN)	
E) Served in the Vietnam War in the forces of the United States or its allies during this war and who was a Canadian citizen at the time of such service	
F) Currently serving and retired members of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police	
Please Note: All previous holders of Ontario Veteran licence plates will automatically be grandfathered under the new eligibility criteria

Retired Personnel - Copy of Canadian Forces discharge certificate, certificate of service (or equivalent for Merchant Navy, Allied Forces, etc.) or NDI75 CF Identification card	
Serving Personnel - Copy of NDI20 CF Identification card	
Peace Officers - Letter from the applicant's police service confirming his/ her involvement in a NATO operation or a United Nations mission	
Vietnam Service - Statement of service or discharge certificate showing service in Vietnam during the Vietnam War in the United States forces or the forces of its allies this war and proof of Canadian citizenship at the time of service (Canadian birth cer or citizenship document, which shows date of becoming a Canadian citizen.)	
Royal Canadian Mounted Police - Copy of identification card or Certificate of Servi	ice
